Whenever I wonder what God has in store or ask myself, "Why now?" the passage above enters my mind. God has established a time and a purpose for every matter under heaven! Previously when I entered a new appointment, I had to leave behind one congregation entrusting them to another pastor while beginning a new ministry with another congregation. This time is different: I begin a new chapter of ministry in New Milford, while continuing in Cherry Valley. This is new to me, and to many of you.

When the appointment was being made, our District Superintendent shared that in share appointments such as this that it would be expected that I would spend one day for New Milford and three days for Cherry Valley (I presume she meant week days). But that division really only relates to the administrative responsibilities. I expect to be available to all of you throughout the week. When out doing visitation, I intend to use geography (i.e. where folks live in relation to the other visits that day) rather than the day of the week. For Bible Studies, I see the opportunity to lead a morning/day study at New Milford and the same study at Cherry Valley in the evening so that members of each church can attend the session that meets their schedule.

In the beginning, I will be spending additional time with New Milford as I get to know its people and we begin to discover how we can best serve the Lord together. But, a lot of my work (e.g. sermon preparation and worship planning) stays the same. My biggest challenge will be Sunday mornings. I've been in the habit to arrive at church a couple of hours early (around 8:00 to be ready for 10:00 worship) in order settle myself and to make sure things are ready.

Recently, a member asked me, "No that you'll be starting at New Milford, if we have something to do in the afternoon that would have kept us from church, is it okay to attend at New Milford?" God has set an opportunity before us. (BTW: The answer to that question was "Yes.") God has set the time – not only the season, but the time in our midst – for us to grow in our love for him and one another and for our discipleship. In that we can trust.

The passage above concludes, "I know that there is nothing better for them than to be happy and enjoy themselves as long as they live; moreover, it is God's gift that all should eat and drink and take pleasure in all their toil." I serve one master, Jesus Christ. It is a joy to know that I will be able to eat and drink and delight in the work that he puts before us as I enter into ministry in New Millford while getting to continue to serve in Cherry Valley.
